He has always been passionate about technology and was one of the first 100 dentists in the USA to include a hard tissue laser in his practice. He has taught Dental Lasers, Technology, and Minimum Invasive Dentistry, among other subjects.

Dr. Chad Duplantis graduated from the University of Texas Health Science Center in 1999. He then moved on to post-doctoral training at Baylor College of Dentistry. He has been in private practice in North Fort Worth Texas since 2000. As a member of the Catapult Speaker Group, he lectures nationally and internationally on a variety of dental subjects.

Course Description

Technology is here to stay, and the clinical team must be on board to accept the new reality or be left behind.
