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## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Treatment of sleep disorders is one of the fastest growing fields of medicine and recent developments have put dentists on the front line. Dentists have a unique opportunity to save the lives of those suffering while adding a valuable service in your practice. **Day 1** of this seminar will provide an understanding of the physiology of breathing that will allow for a more precise treatment plan to identify the proper way to identify and treat patients with sleep apnea. **Day 2** will provide a hands-on experience in head and neck exams and utilization of test results and fabrication of the appropriate sleep appliances for your patient. Consider that the quality of breath may well increase your patient's quality of life and possibly even their lifespan, as well as the durability of our finished restorative cases.
