COURSE DESCRIPTION

Day 1 of the seminar will detail non-surgical, surgical and regenerative periodontal therapy, surgical and restorative implantology, fixed and removable prosthetics, oral medicine/oral surgery, oral pathology, pediatric and adolescent operative dentistry, endodontics, pedodontics/orthodontics, esthetic/cosmetic dentistry and practice management/marketing. **Day 2** of the seminar will give each participant hands-on experience with the various wavelengths performing surgical procedures on in Vitro models (Pig Mandibles). Real time videos of routine laser procedures will be part of the in-depth discussion of specific instrument settings and techniques for laser surgical procedures.
